Dear Parents and Students,

CERN, or Conseil Européen pour la Recherche Nucléaire, to give it its full title, is the world's largest particle physics laboratory.

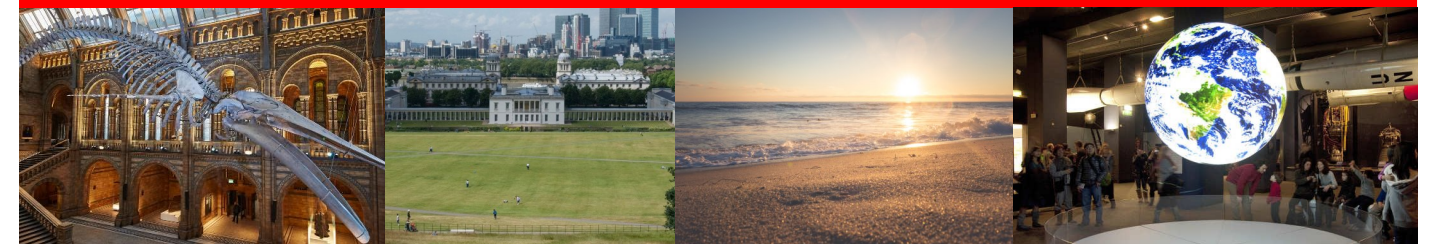

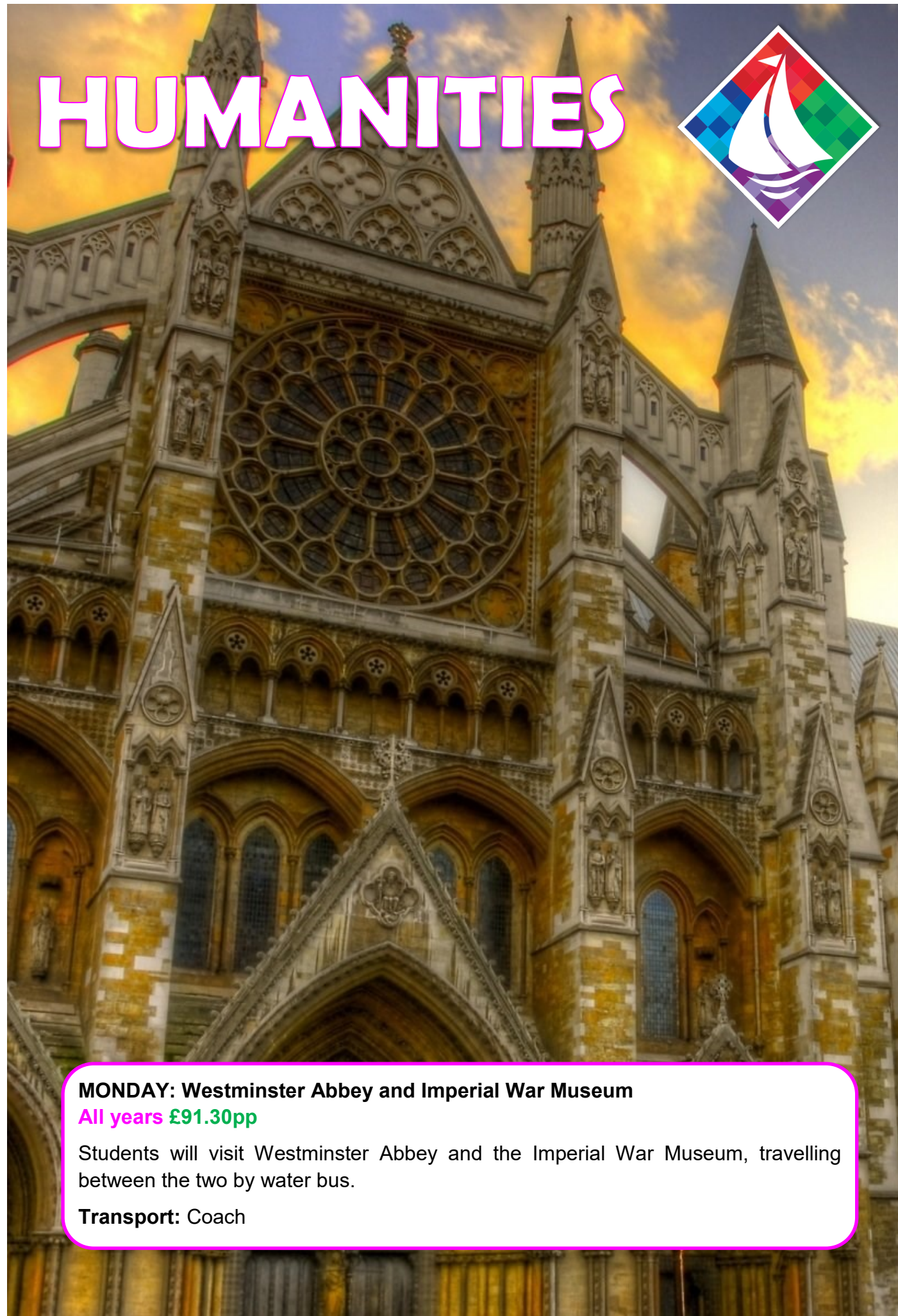
