Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to Activities Week 2024. This week in June promises to be packed full of even more exciting opportunities than last year and will enrich the experience of students at Trafalgar School.

Each department area has planned a variety of activities, which focus on enhancing the learning of students in their subject, but which will also undoubtedly bring excitement and enjoyment to all. As a key part of our curriculum offer, we see this week as our chance to get out into the community far and wide.

As you will go on to read, you will see there are many options and this will make for some tough decisions. Firstly, I would encourage you to consider the following carefully: the cost of the activities (we have tried very hard to keep these to a minimum); any restrictions on activities (such as age) and travel requirements. Take time to discuss the choices before making any selections, if you require more information about an activity, contact the Curriculum Director of that department.

It is important the choices selected are those that students are committed to undertaking. There will be a lot of advance planning and organisation to ensure the week runs smoothly. Therefore, once the choices are made, activities will need to be booked quickly to avoid disappointment as any changes become very difficult to achieve.

Choices forms, found at the back of the brochure, will need to be returned to Form Tutors by no later than 20th October 2023. Non-refundable deposits of £10 for day trips and activities are due by 5th January 2024. Residential trip deposits are also non refundable but are higher due to the higher cost of the trip.

Please select a maximum of three activities per day, with 'activity one' being the preferred choice Your child will only undertake one activity on any given day. You may also choose to select the Mystery Activity, which will involve no cost and the details of these will be decided nearer the time.

To ensure staff and student safety it is essential that all students demonstrate across the school year, behaviour that consistently demonstrates our school values. If at any point during the school year we are concerned that your child's behaviour in school poses a risk to themselves or any members our community, we will contact you to discuss their continued participation on this trip. If your child is removed from this trip because of behaviour concerns, we will refund payments, minus the non-refundable deposit, only if we are able to resell their place.

Finally, we do not want the cost of trips to be a barrier to students taking part. If your child is in receipt of the Pupil Premium grant, you will receive by post an Activities Week gift voucher to spend across the week. I hope that you will agree this is an exciting part of our curriculum at Trafalgar School and firmly believe the week will be a great success!
