

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to Activities Week 2025!

This week in June promises to be packed full of even more exciting opportunities than previous years and will enrich the experience of students at Trafalgar School.

Each department has planned a variety of activities, which focus on enhancing the learning of students in their subject, but which will also undoubtedly bring excitement and enjoyment to all. As a key part of our curriculum offer, we see this week as our chance to get out into the community far and wide.

As you will see, there are many options, and this will make for some tough decisions. Firstly, I would encourage you to consider the following carefully: the cost of the activities (we have tried very hard to keep a range of varied priced activities including free and low cost options available on each day) any restrictions on activities (such as age) and travel requirements. Take time to discuss the choices before making any selections and if you require more information about an activity, please contact the Curriculum Director of that department.

It is important the choices selected are those that students are committed to undertaking. There will be a lot of advance planning and organisation to ensure the week runs smoothly. Therefore, once the choices are made, activities will be booked quickly to avoid disappointment.

Choices forms, found at the back of the brochure, will need to be returned to Form Tutors by no later than 18th October 2024. Non-refundable deposits of £10 for all day trips and activities are due by 29th November 2024 to secure your child's place. Residential trip deposits are also non refundable but are higher due to the higher cost of the trip.

Please select a maximum of three activities per day, with 'activity one' being the preferred choice; your child will only undertake one activity on any given day. There is a day by day guide towards the end of this booklet to help you plan out your week.

To ensure staff and student safety it is essential that all students demonstrate across the school year, behaviour that consistently demonstrates our school values. If at any point during the school year we are concerned that your child's behaviour in school poses a risk to themselves or other members our community attending the trip, we will contact you to discuss their continued participation. If your child is removed from this trip because of behaviour concerns, we will refund payments, minus the non-refundable deposit, only if we are able to resell their place.

Finally, we do not want the cost of trips to be a barrier to students from taking part. If your child is in receipt of the Pupil Premium grant, you will receive by post an Activities Week gift voucher to spend across the week. I hope that you will agree this is an exciting part of our curriculum at Trafalgar School and firmly believe the week will be a great success!




WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY: Gothic London Residential YEARS 9&10 £185



They then use real astronomical data in this session to travel through the solar system investigating the orbits of the planets.






MONDAY—FRIDAY: Athens Residential YEARS 8-10 £950


WEDNESDAY—FRIDAY: Auschwitz and Krakow Residential YEARS 8-10 £ 755

We will have a guided tour of the museum dedicated to life in Krakow during the Nazi Occupation and visit KZ Plaszow Krakow's Concentration Camp. We will also visit Auschwitz, with a guided tour including learning about the camp history. We will then go on to visit the site of Birkenau with a guided tour around the site.

We will also be meeting with either a Holocaust Survivor or a recipient of the 'Righteous Among the Nations.

Included is an amazing Wieliczka Salt Mines which is a UNESCO world heritage site. Wieliczka is one of the oldest salt mines in the world!




