Welcome to Trafalgar School! I am delighted to have been notified by Portsmouth City Council of your child's placement at Trafalgar School for September 2025. I am writing to inform you about important dates relating to your child's transition to secondary school.

You are warmly invited to attend our New Intake Parents' Evening, in school, on Thursday 3rd April 2025. This will be an excellent opportunity to talk to members of the Senior Leadership Team and receive important information about Trafalgar School.

We will be holding two induction days for your child as we are eager for them to experience life at Trafalgar School. This will give them a chance to attend lessons and meet a large number of our staff and students.

New Intake Parents' Evening, Thursday 3rd April 2025

The programme for the evening is as follows:

6.00pm	Presentation with the Executive Headteacher, Mrs C Copeland and Head of School, Miss G Pearse
6.30pm – 7.00pm	Opportunity to meet the Senior Leadership Team and ask any questions that have not been answered.

Induction days, Monday 30th June and Tuesday 1st July 2025

Your child will need to arrive at Trafalgar School both mornings by 8.45am and will be dismissed at 2.30pm. They will be expected to attend in their usual school uniform, equipped with the following: pen, pencil, ruler and rubber in a pencil case. Any student entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch at lunch time. All other students will be required to bring their own lunch. We operate a cashless system, so no food can be purchased during induction days, but water will be available.

Finally, to support your child's smooth transition to secondary school, there is a lot of information we will require from you! You will receive an email soon from Admissions Plus, inviting you to share information with us and there will be further opportunities for you and your child to attend school, including a 1:1 meeting with a senior member of staff.
