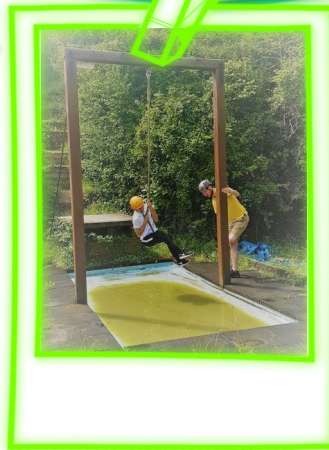

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to our third Activities Week, running from the 29th June to the 3rd July 2020. This promises to be packed full of even more exciting opportunities than last year, which enrich the experience of students at Trafalgar.

Each department area has planned a variety of activities, which focus on enhancing the learning of students in their subject, but will undoubtedly bring excitement and enjoyment. Although many activities will take place at school, we also see this as our chance to get out into the community far and wide. As you will go on to read, there are many options and this will make for some tough decisions.

Firstly, I would encourage you to consider carefully the following: cost of the activities (we have tried very hard to keep these to a minimum) and any restrictions on activities (such as age). It is important the choices selected are those that students are committed to undertaking. There will be a lot of planning and organisation to ensure the week runs smoothly.
