



Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to our third Activities Week, running from the 29th June to the 3rd July 2020. This promises to be packed full of even more exciting opportunities than last year, which enrich the experience of students at Trafalgar.

Each department area has planned a variety of activities, which focus on enhancing the learning of students in their subject, but will undoubtedly bring excitement and enjoyment.
